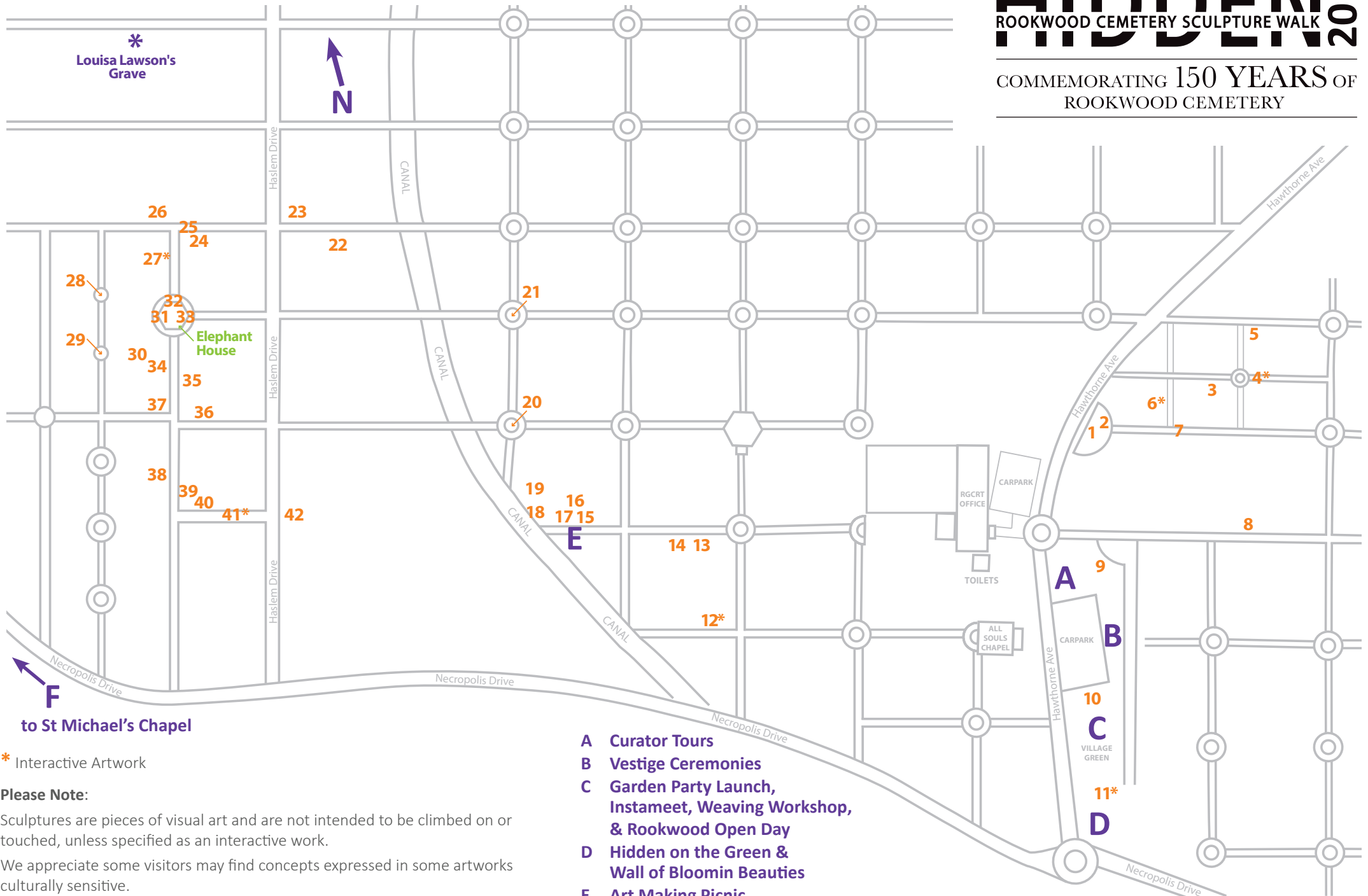

Weaving Workshop

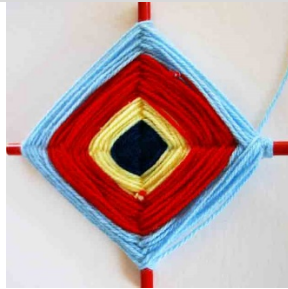
